About Our Speaker

Originally from Wales, Dr. Derek Thomas is the John E. Richards Professor of Systematic and Practical Theology at Reformed Theological Seminary, Jackson, Mississippi. After pastoring for 17 years in Belfast, Northern Ireland, Dr Thomas returned to the USA in 1996 where, in addition to his work at the seminary, he serves as the Minister of Teaching at First Presbyterian Church in Jackson.

He has written or edited 15 books and has contributed to commentary series by Banner of Truth and Evangelical Press. He also co-edited *Give Praise to God: A Vision for Reforming Worship*, (P & R) with Philip Ryken and Ligon Duncan. In 2004, Derek Thomas became Editorial Director for The Alliance of Confessing Evangelicals and the editor of its *e*zine, *Reformation 21* (www.reformation21.org).

His interests include the music of Anton Bruckner, Richard Wagner and Gustav Mahler as well as a passion for good coffee and blue cheese. He has been married to his wife, Rosemary, for almost 30 years. They have two adult children, Ellen and Owen.
